Training Pathway for Sport and Exercise Medicine

College: The Australasian College of Sports and Exercise Physicians (ACSEP)

Candidates are required to successfully complete the required Entrance Examination components before applying to the ACSEP Training Program. Applicants apply directly to the College to gain entry onto the training program.

The Training Program:

1. ACSEP Entrance Examination.
2. ACSEP Fellowship Examination after completing four years full-time training including completion of all training program requirements.
3. Must be conducted in an accredited training post/practice. Trainees must also be involved in Sports Team and Event coverage activities; Research Projects or equivalent; Attend College Conferences and make research presentations; Complete ACSEP Academic model and Workplace Based Assessments; Complete Management of Sporting Trauma Course and complete the Part 2 Examination.
