### Additional information

1. In Queensland, first year basic training positions (BPT1) are recruited and managed directly by the individual Hospital and Health Services (HHS), not via the network. These appointments are generally Junior House Officers or Senior House Officer position level. Visit the available positions webpage ([www.health.qld.gov.au/rmo](http://www.health.qld.gov.au/rmo)) for further details.
2. Second and third year basic physician training placements (BPT2 and BPT3) are recruited and managed through the Queensland basic physician training network. These are Registrar level appointments.

The Townsville Hospital	12	Core Training	Queensland Health manages Advanced Training positions in Nephrology with the goal to offer two candidates a 3 year statewide supported training program through a prospectively coordinated and planned pathway. Candidates need to nominate their transplant year in advance as there are only two positions available at the Queensland Renal Transplant Services per year for the pathway. Please note that Princess Alexandra Hospital Renal department have available at least two more Advanced Training positions in Nephrology which includes training in renal transplants outside of the two centralised pathway positions.
