CRITERIA, SCOPE AND PROCESS

Students who received a scholarship or bursary for 2025 are not eligible to apply for a scholarship or bursary for 2026. Applicants are awarded a scholarship or bursary based on a collection of information, as follows:

ACADEMIC

- ❖ Academic performance (not necessarily academic excellence)
- Effort and cooperation

CITIZENSHIP

- Contribution to life at OLSH
- Christian Ethos / Good Character
- Role model
- Attendance record

PROCESS of SELECTION

- 1. Campus executives (Traeger and Sadadeen) are asked to rank the applications from their campus.
- 2. Each member of the College Advisory Board Scholarships Committee is asked to rank the applications.
- 3. The Advisory Board Scholarships Committee assesses the applications by considering their own ranking and that done by the Campus Executives.
- 4. The Advisory Board Scholarship Committee makes its recommendations to the College Advisory Board, which then awards the scholarship/bursaries. These are announced at Presentation Night at the end of the year. (Any member of the Board who has a child applying for a scholarship/bursary is excluded from the selection process)
