
### MarinaNews


A berth at the Cairns Marlin Marina can be booked by contacting the Cairns Seaport Operations Office or by completing our <u>online booking form</u>.

# Updated Extreme Weather Contingency Plan

Queensland has a new emergency warning system, in line with the rest of the country. This is called the Australian Warning System (AWS). For vessels operating in a Queensland port, the local Harbour Master will issue emergency alerts for Marina operators and vessel masters to act on. In preparation for the upcoming cyclone season the Regional Harbour Master has updated the Extreme Weather Contingency Plan and unveiled the new dashboard which shows the current port status and links to relevant information. We recommend everyone familiarises themselves with the updated plan and new warning system prior to the commencement of the declared cyclone season. # Enhanced Security Upgrades Successfully Completed

The safety and security of our marina community has always been a priority. We are delighted to inform you about the completion of the enhanced security upgrades designed to ensure a safe and secure environment for all our customers. Upgrades include:


- Extension of wing panels at access gates to improve control and access management.
- Installation of spikes for deterring unauthorised access and enhancing perimeter security.
- Extension of the black security fence between H Finger and Sailfish Quay to provide a secure boundary.
- Addition of CCTV cameras strategically placed to enhance surveillance across the marina premises.

#### **Parking Regulations**

We kindly request that all marina users adhere to the designated parking regulations. Properly parked vehicles help maintain smooth traffic flow and ensure everyone's convenience.

The Boardwalk Carpark has 2-hour spaces and 20min loading zones from 6:00am to 6:00pm. Kindly adhere to these limits to allow access for all patrons and service providers. At the Long-Term Carpark, a permit must be always displayed on your dashboard. This permit is essential for managing long-term parking needs efficiently. The Marina Point carpark is a pay and display public carpark where payment is required.

# New Waste Oil Facility Completed at Marina Point

We are pleased to announce that a new waste oil facility has been completed at Cairns Marlin Marina. This facility has being built to ensure proper disposal of waste oil from vessels, contributing to the preservation of our pristine marine environment. We request that only waste oil is disposed in the receptacle and all other liquid waste is to be left in sealed containers on the designated racks within the enclosure.
