Housekeeping

Once you have arrived we offer a few little superyacht extras during your stay.

- **Access Cards** - These provide access to your yacht. If you need more please call the marina on 4052 3866.
- **Rubbish Bins** - Located behind the black gate. You are welcome to take one on to the dock – but don't forget to put it out overnight as collection is really early each morning.
 Yellow lid bins are for recycling material (please feel free to use a little anger management to flatten those cardboard boxes).
 Green lid bins are for general waste (except for nasties like paints, flammables or oil).
 If you have a large quantity of waste to be removed we can organise a ute/truck for you.
- **CCTV** - There are plenty of cameras about the marina to keep an eye on your vessel. It would also help to make sure the gates are shut at all times.
- **Mail** - Any mail or packages can be sent to the Marina and we will deliver it to the yacht for you.

- **Internet/Wi Fi password** - This is a hidden network so the credentials need to be entered manually.

- **The Local Newspaper** – The Cairns Post will be delivered to your vessel each morning from Monday to Saturday.
- **Work Platforms** – We know sometimes you have to do a bit of work - even in paradise - so we have two floating platforms (4m x 2m) available for hire. Just give us a call and we'll arrange it.
- **Work permits** – But don't forget you have to have a work permit for any hot/cold works to your vessel. It's easy to get one, just go on line at: <https://www.portsnorth.com.au/cmm/forms-maps/cmm-hot-cold-works-permit>.
- **Refits** - If it's a bigger project, we can point you to the excellent Cairns marine and yacht refit precinct only five minutes away. It's the perfect haul-out and maintenance location for all vessels.
