		10. Materials Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) has been checked for correct procedures/ additional controls (if applicable to product)
		11. Spill Response Kits suitable for product are accessible
		12. Waste Tracking Certificates for regulated waste transfer/disposal by licensed contractor have been completed / are required for this operation?
		13. Work Procedures have been checked and implemented for this task
