### Personal Appearance and Uniform Regulations

Dear Junior Campus and Senior Campus Parents and Caregivers,

Thank you for choosing Ryan Catholic College for your child's education. This document provides clarity regarding our College regulations. Thank you for your support.

The following information is our updated Uniform regulations effective immediately.

#### APPEARANCE

- Students should be neat and tidy in their school uniform at all times.
- Boys will come to school clean-shaven.
- No visible tattoos are permitted.

#### JEWELLERY

- If a student is wearing earrings, the only permitted earrings are a single plain gold or silver stud (no more than 4mm in diameter) or a single plain gold or silver sleeper (no more than 1.5 cm outer diameter and with a width/thickness of 1mm) per ear lobe. The wearing of pearl or pearl like earrings, diamonds, stones or other designer earrings is **not** permitted.
- Earrings (stud or sleepers) are the ONLY acceptable form of body piercing allowed. See below:



A second small clear plastic stud may be worn in the ear.



One simple linked metal chain necklace no more than 2 mm across, with or without a small cross or other religious symbol, may be worn.

- Rings may not be worn.
- All students may wear one plain, simple watch. Anklets or bracelets are not permitted.

## MAKE UP

- Makeup, nail polish, fake nails, eyelash extensions and fake eyelashes are not permitted.

## HAIR

- Students are permitted to have colours that are subtle and natural looking; the College's stance is one of moderation.
- If students add colour to their hair, for example fine foils or highlights, then it must be close to natural colour. Streaks and tips are not permitted.
- Long fringes, undercuts and untidy hair around the face, dreadlocks, mullets, rat tails, tracks and shaving patterns of any form are **not** permitted. There should be no dramatic differences in hair length, e.g. not shaved/short on sides and/or top but long at the back.
- Hair is to be no shorter than a blade 2 (6 mm) cut.
- Hair must be out of the eyes.
- It is a requirement that all students' hair should be kept clean and well-groomed at all times.
- Hair ties **ONLY** may be natural hair colour.
- Top knots are not permitted.
- Hair of shoulder length or longer is to be neatly tied back. It is to be worn neatly and fastened with scrunchies, ribbons or clips in gold, navy blue, sky blue (school colours).

- No 'light up' or wheelie shoes are allowed.

### Academic Uniform

Black Leather Velcro Shoes (P-4 only)

OR

Black Leather Lace Up Shoes (*black laces*)

OR

Plain Black Leather Lace Up Joggers (*black laces*)

### Sports Uniform

### PROCEDURE FOR BREACHES
