Early Bird Discount

1. A 5% discount will be given to families off the total tuition fees for the year if the yearly account is paid off in full by Friday 8th March 2019.
2. For students starting in the middle of the year would be entitled to Early Bird Discount as per point 1 above, if they pay their full year school fees (proportionate fees) within 4 weeks of the start date.

Multiple Student Discount

Families are entitled to a discount to a percentage of tuition fee only, if multiple students from the same family attend Catholic Schools across the Northern Territory. The discount will be applied in the following manner to ensure all schools share the discount.

First and eldest child	- full amount of tuition fee
Second child	- 5% of each child's tuition fee
Third child	- 10% of each child's tuition fee
Fourth and subsequent child	- 33% of each child's tuition fee

Concessions

Families requiring support/concessions need to contact the Business Manager and submit an application. Concessions are available to families at the discretion of the Principal only.

Student Withdrawal and Refund

A term notice in writing must be given to the Finance Officer before a student is withdrawn from the College. Failure to provide with the notice will result in fees being charged for the period by which the notice falls short of a term (1 term = 10 weeks).

Payment Information

The following payment options are available to pay your school fees.

1. Bpay – See Invoice for details
2. Direct Debit – Forms available with Finance Officer
3. Cheque – Please see Finance Officer or send by mail
4. Cash or Credit Card (Visa or Mastercard) – Please see Finance Officer for these options

The Finance Officer can assist you with setting up a direct debit and other payment options as well, if required. Please call 08 8982 2222 and ask for the School Fees or the Finance Officer if you have any enquiries or require assistance.

Please note: School fees are due strictly by the due date. If payment cannot be made by the due date, please contact our Finance Officer for organising a payment plan.
If the account remains outstanding, follow up action will include referring account to a debt collection agency. Please note that fees are subject to increase at the beginning of 2020.



Below is a breakdown of information related to the Curriculum and Resource Levy

- 1. Building and Maintenance**– This helps to repair and maintain the buildings and grounds of the College. We use this for upgrades, painting, air-conditioning, maintenance and upkeep.
- 2. IT and Computer** – This levy covers the costs of individual laptops, iPads and desktops that are available for student use at the College. It also covers the constant updates of programs, software and insurance and the safe high-speed network.
- 3. Resources and Curriculum** – This includes all classroom and subject resources. It also covers the costs of subscriptions for subjects, textbooks, sporting equipment and supplies for sports and Health and Physical Education.
- 4. Whole School Events** – This covers all cost associated with whole school events, such as Athletics and Swimming Carnival, Masses, Art Show, Sacred Heart Day, etc.

The school fees also cover Student administration cost, which includes the supply of one student diary for each student, one student ID card per year, school magazine for the family and photocopying and printing costs by the student for the year.
