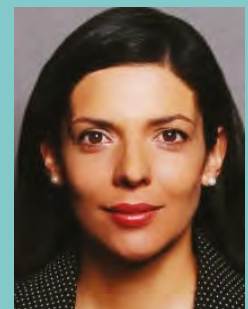
This event will be compered by: *Magistrate Sandra Pearson*, and *Naomi de Costa*. And will include a short poetry performance by *Zoe Perwiti*.

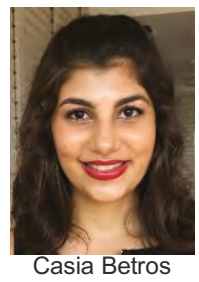
