GETTING STARTED

In Queensland, children can attend Kindy if they are 4 by the the 30th of June in the year they start.

GET YOUR CHILD KINDY READY

A health check at your local Aboriginal Medical Service is a great way to make sure your child is healthy and ready for Kindy. A health check can make sure your child doesn't have any problems that might get in the way of learning, such as a hearing or eyesight problem.

Your local clinic can provide access to a range of child therapy services that will help them get ready for Kindy.
