

Teacher Education Scholarships for University Students in their final two years of study

What's on offer for recipients?

• \$10,000 allowance (\$5,000 per year) for the final two years of study in an approved teacher education course

Professional experience support

- \$170 per week (rural/remote) or \$140 per week (Townsville) living allowance during final year professional experience placement in a Catholic school *
- Travel expenses
- Assistance with organising accommodation while on professional experience placement

Eligibility criteria

- Be an Australian citizen
- Reside in, or be willing to reside in, the Townsville Diocese
- Be in third year of an approved undergraduate Bachelor of Education or first year of a two year Master of Teaching in 2026

Conditions of scholarship recipients

Recipients must sign a contract with Townsville Catholic Education relating to the conditions of the scholarship.

To retain the scholarship, recipients:

- Must remain in the education degree identified at the time of the application
- Must pass all subjects and maintain a course GPA of 4.0 or above. Where a recipient
 fails to meet this requirement, evidence of special circumstances to the reduced GPA
 must be provided to the Selection Committee for consideration of ongoing eligibility
- Must successfully complete and pass all professional experience placements
- Must complete at least one professional experience placement in a Townsville Catholic Education school in their final year of study
- May only defer or request suspension of their scholarship in exceptional circumstances
- Must accept an employment contract in a Townsville Catholic Education school for two years on completion of their course.

^{*} If you are on Permission to Teach you are not eligible for the professional experience support

How to apply

- 1. Complete the application form
- 2. Have two people complete the referee report. Referees are to submit the report directly to TCE via email to Louise Dunlop and Melanie Singh at scholarships@tsv.catholic.edu.au
- 3. Return the scholarship documentation to the Townsville Catholic Education Office in person or via email 10 October 2025.
 - Application form
 - Most recent academic transcript (unofficial)
 - All professional experience reports
 - Resume
 - Copy of Blue Card
- 4. Your application will be assessed based on university academic results, professional experience reports, application information, referee reports, and commitment to work in Catholic schools in the Townsville Diocese for two years after qualifying as a teacher.
