

Teacher Education Scholarships for First Year University Students

First year of Bachelor of Education in 2026

What's on offer for recipients?

- \$10,000 allowance (\$2,500 per year) for each year of an approved four year teacher education course
- Professional development opportunities provided by TCE

Professional experience support

- \$170 per week (rural/remote) or \$140 per week (Townsville) living allowance during final year professional experience placement in a Catholic school *
- Travel expenses
- Assistance with organising accommodation while on professional experience placement

Eligibility criteria

- Be an Australian citizen
- Reside in, or be willing to reside in, the Townsville Diocese
- Be in first year of an approved undergraduate Bachelor of Education in 2026
- Be willing to work in a Townsville Catholic Education school for two years after qualifying as a teacher.*

Conditions of scholarship recipients

Recipients must sign an agreement with Townsville Catholic Education relating to the conditions of the scholarship.

To retain the scholarship, recipients:

- Must remain in the education degree identified at the time of the application
- Must pass all subjects and maintain a course GPA of 4.0 or above. Where a recipient
 fails to meet this requirement, evidence of special circumstances to the reduced GPA
 must be provided to the Selection Committee for consideration of ongoing eligibility
- Must successfully complete and pass all professional experience placements
- Must complete a professional experience placement in a Townsville Catholic Education school in their final year of study
- May only defer or request suspension of their scholarship in exceptional circumstances
- Must accept an employment contract (if offered) at a Townsville Catholic Education school for two years on completion of their course

^{*} If you are on Permission to Teach you are not eligible for the professional experience support

How to apply

- 1. Complete the application form
- 2. Have two people complete the referee report. Referees are to submit the report directly to TCE via email to Louise Dunlop -scholarships@tsv.catholic.edu.au
- 3. Return the scholarship documentation to the Townsville Catholic Education Office in person or via email to scholarships@tsv.catholic.edu.au by 26th September, 2025

 - Copy of Blue Card
 - Most recent school report card (if applicable)
- 4. Your application will be assessed based on application information, referee reports, and commitment to work in Catholic schools in the Townsville Diocese for two years after qualifying as a teacher.
