

#### Scholarships for school students who are aspiring teachers

Scholarships available for Year 10 students who are interested in becoming a teacher

#### What's on offer for recipients?

- Complete the Certificate III in School Based Education Support or Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care in Year 11 at no cost, with work placement one day per week in a Catholic school (optional)
- Complete two JCU, CQU, ACU or USQ Education subjects online in Year 11/12 at no cost
- The option to apply for a second scholarship once enrolled in an approved education degree

#### Eligibility criteria

- Be an Australian citizen
- Reside in the Townsville Diocese
- Be completing Year 11 at a Townsville Catholic Education school in 2026
- Have aspirations to become a teacher
- Have enrolled in school subjects that meet prerequisite requirements for entry into an education degree

#### **Conditions of scholarship recipients**

Recipients must sign an agreement with Townsville Catholic Education relating to the conditions of the scholarship.

To retain the scholarship, recipients:

- Must remain enrolled at a Townsville Catholic Education school in Year 11 and 12
- Must complete two university Education subjects during Year 11 and/or 12
