
ST MARY'S 2022 ANNUAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

RESPONSIVE PLANNING

This year we are working to embed responsive planning through engagement with Townsville Catholic Education's Learning and Teaching Cycle.

At St Mary's, our focus is on knowing our students and how they learn. Responsive planning is about ensuring our teaching is responsive to the needs of each child. This is achieved through careful monitoring and the continual redesign of lessons in order to address any gaps or lack of progress. Rather than simply teaching a set of pre-designed lessons across a term, our teachers continually assess the effectiveness of their teaching and the learning of each student.

We acknowledge the work of Mrs Krystal Land as Learning and Teaching Adviser in this space. Mrs Land leads our staff professional development and works alongside teachers every week during their planning time. Together they study their class data, reflect on the most effective teaching methods and devise strategies to best support their students' learning.



We hope you take time to reflect on the information offered in this Special Report, and as always, we welcome your feedback.


