2022 promises to be another wonderful year of engaging, meaningful and rigorous work in the classrooms of St Mary's school! During the school year, we will continue to build upon the solid foundation of academic achievement laid by Colette in her time as principal over the last four years.

The extra two weeks afforded to us by the premier's announcement have enabled our teachers to work from home planning intensively for our now condensed term. This preparation time would not have been possible without the tireless efforts of our school officers who have diligently supervised the students of essential workers for the last two weeks. Thank you to the families who have rearranged their schedules to accommodate their children at home for an extra two weeks and facilitated the at-home learning activities provided by our teachers.

As you are no doubt aware, the premier recently outlined further measures to be undertaken as part of their COVID-Safe back-to-school plan. Some of these temporary measures will directly impact our arrangements for the first four weeks of school. Our Year 6 camp will be postponed, school assemblies and masses will be live-streamed to classes, and P & F Association and Board meetings will be held via Zoom. Further information will be distributed to parents in the coming days.



One of the directives issued by the premier and supported by the Townsville Catholic Education Office is that schools must *"limit visitors, including parents, to school sites with exceptions for parents and carers of students experiencing vulnerability, and all students attending Prep or Year 1."* As a result the following arrangements are in place for drop off and pick up times:

<u>Parents of students Year 2 to Year 6</u> are kindly asked to drop their children off at the gate from Monday next week rather than coming into classes. Teachers will be available to welcome the students and help them unpack. Parents of students new to the school are invited to walk them to class.

<u>Parents of students in Year One</u> are invited to drop their children off at the gate or come in and wait for the bell with their children in the "Big Shed". At the bell, the children will line up with their teacher in the undercover area and wave goodbye to their parents before moving off to class.

<u>Prep students and their parents</u> are invited to gather in the Junior Playground before school starts. As the prep room is not an adequate size to accommodate all 28 preps and their parents in a COVID safe manner, parents will be invited in small groups to take their children into Prep. Once inside the first group can support their preppies to unpack their bags and settle into table activities before saying their goodbyes in order to allow the next group of parents to bring their children into class.

I understand that these conditions are not ideal, but rest assured our teachers are committed to ensuring your child/ren's first few weeks of school are settled, safe, and enjoyable. The first day back to school is a day of excitement and trepidation for many children (and parents). It is important that as parents we are positive about the year ahead for our children even if we are apprehensive. Our attitude to school will set the scene for a positive year ahead and our assurance that they are able to handle and overcome challenges will help develop their resilience and ability to cope.

Along with the St Mary's staff, I look forward to a very productive semester working in partnership with you in your child's educational journey.
