School Uniform 2021

Clothing

Formal Uniform

Students in **Years 1 to 6** are required to wear the formal uniform each day, **except** for when their class has an allocated Physical Education lesson (differs according to class) or Sport (Fridays). The formal uniform options, supplied by The School Locker, are:

Girls: blouse and skirt (with built in tights); blouse and shorts; dress and tie.

Boys: shirt and shorts (two style options for shorts)



Sports Uniform

Students in **Prep** are required to wear the sports uniform each day. Students in **Years 1 to 6** are required to wear the sports uniform on days when their class has an allocated Physical Education lesson (differs according to class) or Sport (Fridays).

The sports uniform consists of a school polo shirt and sport shorts, as supplied by The School Locker. Students have an option to wear a **plain coloured shirt** in their house colour, in place of their school polo shirt on special house event days (swimming, athletics and cross-country carnivals, or other house events as advised). **Year 6 students** have the option to wear the specially designed **Seniors polo shirt** in place of the regular school polo shirt.



Hat

Students are to wear the school bucket hat, supplied by The School Locker, any time it is required, including to and from school each day and whenever they are outside the classroom.



Head coverings

Head coverings, if worn, are to be of school colours: purple, teal, blue, navy, yellow, white or black.

Jacket

Students should wear the school jacket, as supplied from The School Locker, when needed. Additional clothing layers can be worn for warmth **under** the school uniform and jacket, though must **not** be visible.

Long pants

Plain **navy** or **black** tights or tracksuits pants can be worn when needed.



Footwear

Socks

Students are to wear **SBCS socks**, as supplied by The School Locker, or **plain white socks** each day. White socks should **cover the ankle bone** and have no other visible colours.



Shoes

Students are to wear **plain black, covered in shoes** each day. The entire shoe, including the sole and laces, should be black only (a small brand label on the tongue is an exception). Shoes may be of a 'jogger' or 'formal' style, may have Velcro or laces, and **must be suitable for physical activity**.

Shoes **should not**: have any other visible colours, be of an open (e.g. 'Mary Jane') style or be made of canvas or other soft unstable material.

Personal Presentation

Hair and hair accessories

Students' hair must be kept **natural, well-groomed** and **off the face**. Hair that reaches the uniform collar is to be tied back with simple hair accessories. Hair accessories, if worn, are to be of school colours: purple, teal, blue, navy, yellow, white or black.

Jewellery

Students may wear simple, tidy jewellery items, which include: one pair of plain studs or small sleepers worn in the ear lobes; a simple wristwatch; a flat signet ring; and a plain metal chain with a religious medal or cross.

Nail polish and other items

Nail polish, acrylic nails, make up, tattoos or similar are not to be worn to school.

Bags

Students may bring any neat and tidy **school bag**. There is no school uniform bag. All students are also required to have a **library bag**. An **optional** school library bag is available from The School Locker.
