Heading further into the Gold Coast you'll find Robina Town Centre and Pacific Fair, as well as the trendy nightlife precincts of Surfers Paradise and Broadbeach.

Weekend sailors can take advantage of five marinas within close proximity to Foreshore Coomera. Public transport to Brisbane CBD and Robina can be easily accessed with the Coomera Train Station just minutes away. The Pacific Motorway is a quick drive along Foxwell Road, providing a direct route to the Brisbane CBD, approximately a 57 kilometre drive to the north, and Australia's most well-known tourist destination, the Gold Coast, only a 27 kilometre drive to the south of Foreshore Coomera.
