CONDITIONS

This liquor licence is subject to the conditions outlined in Part 4 of the *Liquor Act 2019* (Act), as well as the specific conditions applicable to each authority detailed in Part 4 of the *Liquor Regulations 2019* (Regulations). It is also subject to the special conditions listed below.

TRADING HOURS

With the exception of bush orders, liquor shall be sold only for consumption away from the premises using the following hours:

- 1) Monday to Friday between the hours of 16:00 and 19:00;
- 2) Saturday and Public Holidays between the hours of 16:00 and 19:00; and
- 3) No trading on Sunday, Good Friday or Christmas Day.

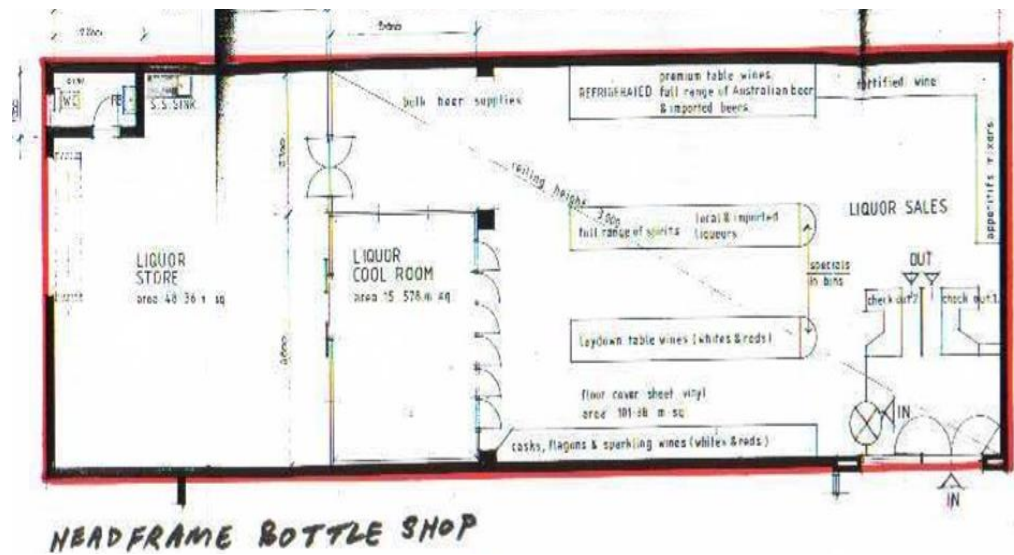
SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Bush Orders	The Commission determines that people placing bush orders, being bona fide orders from bush communities, cattle stations or work camps remote from Tennant Creek, be permitted to purchase up to seven (7) "days' worth" or liquor as set out in the Takeaway Restrictions below. To establish their bona fides for the purpose of purchasing liquor pursuant to this special condition, orders must be placed on accounts and received by telephone or email at least one day in advance. All documentation must be retained for each order and made available to an Inspector of Licensed Premises on request.
Takeaway Restrictions	Liquor sold for consumption away from the premises will be limited to no more than one of the following products per person per day: (a) 30 cans or stubbies of mid-strength or light beer; or (b) 24 cans or stubbies of full strength beer; or (c) 12 cans or bottles of Ready to Drink (RTDs) mixes; or (d) One two litre cask of wine; or (e) One bottle of fortified wine; or (f) One bottle of Green Ginger Wine; or (g) Two 750ml bottle of wine; or (h) One 750ml bottle of spirits. The sale of port, wine in glass container larger than one litre and beer in bottles of 750ml or more remains prohibited. Except Darwin Stubby Souvenir packs.

Taxi Drivers	Liquor may not be sold to a taxi driver where the taxi driver is acting as the purchasing agent for a third party, or in circumstances which might lead the reasonable person to believe that the liquor purchased is not for the taxi driver's personal consumption.
Advertising	The price of alcohol products shall not be advertised: (a) On the external surfaces of the licensed premises; (b) On billboards and blackboards etc. outside the premises; or (c) In free newspapers, promotional pamphlets, circulars or posters.
Darwin Stubby Souvenir Pack	Darwin Stubby Souvenir packs shall only be sold for consumption away from the premises. The souvenir pack shall only be sold at room temperature and in the presentation box.
Camera Surveillance	The licensee shall comply with such requirements for and in relation to camera surveillance as the Director of Liquor Licensing shall at any time notify to the licensee in writing as being thereafter applicable to the licensed premises.
Adequate Security	Adequate security at licensed premises shall be provided in the manner approved by the Director of Liquor Licensing.
Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs	The licensee or an employee of the licensee must exclude or remove from the premises anyone who is wearing the colours, insignia or emblems of an outlaw motorcycle gang (aka bikie gang), or ask police to remove them if they feel unsafe doing so themselves.
Variation of Conditions by Liquor Commission 28 May 2021	(a) The licensee must install, maintain and operate a camera surveillance system in compliance with the requirements and guidelines prescribed by the Director, including CCTV camera surveillance at the point of sale designed and operated so as to record information regarding the items purchased, the use of the BDR scanner, interactions between the purchaser and the salesperson, the appearance of the purchaser and the appearance of the salesperson. The licensee must retain all data captured by the camera surveillance system for not less than 14 days. The licensee must maintain a register of the CCTV including a daily log of the date and time check, as well as any use of the system by the licensee, an employee of the licensee, inspector or police officer. The system is to be protected from unauthorised use and the register must be produced to the Director on request. (b) If a PALI or POSI officer is in attendance at the premises, the licensee must not conduct the sale of liquor for consumption off the premises until the PALI or POSI officers has completed checking the customer's credentials and indicated they do not intend to prevent the customer from entering or remaining on the premises, and do not intend to direct the licensee or the licensee's employees not to sell liquor to the customer. (c) Takeaway Restriction – pending system update.

CERTIFICATE OF DECLARATION

Liquor Act 2019

SECTION 298(1)(b)
