

Harry Hyland Scholarship 2017

The Parramatta College is offering one person access to a predetermined qualification for no fee.

This scholarship was established in 2017 to honour the vast contribution made to the college by Harry Hyland. Harry was President of the College Board for 14 years.



This year, the qualification offered is *Certificate I in Information, Digital Media and Technology (ICT10115)*.

Eligibility:

The recipient must be:

- Australian Citizen or permanent resident, humanitarian visa, bridging visa, asylum seeker or refugee.
- Able to meet the requirements of the qualification.
- Able to demonstrate an interest in the qualification but are experiencing financial hardship or educational disadvantage.
- Must not have achieved other qualifications relevant to Information Technology.

Value: \$1990

Number awarded: 1

Study mode and Duration: Flexible delivery (Mixed "one on one" with "at home" work), up to 1 year. Duration based on recipient's needs.

Application process:

1. Complete the Scholarship application form.
