CHILD PROTECTION

The Parramatta College is an adult education centre, with a minimum student age of 14yrs and 9 months. From time to time, therefore, we have students who are in the age categories defined by child protection legislation as child (up to 16 years) and young person (16 & 17 years).

The NSW Government requires us to comply with child protection legislation in relation to all staff in direct and unsupervised contact with children or young people. Because most of our staff members are unsupervised, and we cannot and do not want to restrict the access of people under 18 to our programs, the College has decided that all paid and unpaid employees and volunteers will be considered to be in child related employment.

OUR BEHAVIOUR

Avoid any behaviour that may be interpreted as improper. of a sexual nature or harassment towards all students, staff and visitors, including children and young people. If you are in any doubt about how people might interpret behaviour or comments in your classroom, you should put a stop to it, politely but firmly.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

You'll provide the following before you start working with us:

100 points of identification, including photo ID. For example, Medicare card, drivers licence, passport A signed prohibited employment declaration A signed and completed consent to screening form.

The NSW Department of Education and Training Screening Unit will organise a police check.
