# THE PERTH ROYAL SHOW

**Thousands of volunteers assist the Royal Agricultural Society of WA (RASWA) to stage the State's largest scale event, the Perth Royal Show.**

Volunteers are welcome to assist everyday for the Show, in either the morning or the afternoon. The Show runs from 26 September to 3 October.

The minimum age to volunteer is 12 years old and we would like volunteers to attend for a minimum of three shifts.

## EVENT VOLUNTEERS

### INFORMATION BOOTHS

Staffing the Information Booth at the three main entry gates: Railway Station, Gate 1 and Gate 10. Volunteers direct people to the different areas in the Showground, or answer questions about what's on, where the activities, ATM's and toilets are located around the ground.

### ROVING INFORMATION VOLUNTEERS

In this role, volunteers walk around the Showground answering questions, giving directions, handing out maps and programs.

### MEET AND GREET

In this role, you will be stationed at entry gates, handing out maps and programs as well as answering questions.

### ANIMAL AREAS

Staffing the **Pat a Pig, Pat a Bunny, Cuddle a Chicken, Cuddle a Cavy and Love a Lamb** patting pens is a rewarding experience. Volunteers in these areas need to supervise the entrance gate to control the number of people visiting the exhibit, ensuring the animals do not escape and are handled appropriately. A RASWA vest is supplied, not a RASWA polo shirt.

## EVENT VOLUNTEERS

### COOKERY

You will need to be confident talking to the public and answering questions. If you are unsure of the answer, be prepared to find out or direct the person to the appropriate steward. We are also seeking volunteers who have experience and knowledge with Jams and Preserves. If this sounds like you, contact us now to volunteer.

### CRAFT

We are seeking volunteers who have some knowledge and experience in any crafts to assist the public with queries regarding the exhibited display and how to enter future competitions. You will need to be confident talking to the public and answering questions. If you are unsure of the answer, be prepared to find out or direct the person to the appropriate steward. You will be required to ensure the displays are not handled and where appropriate you may be required to assist the demonstrators during set up. Please note you will be walking around and standing for majority of your shift.

## SECTION VOLUNTEERS
