2018 Perth Royal Wine Awards

Up to 2000 entries have been put forward into this year's Perth Royal Wine Awards, with over 60 new wineries contributing for the very first time. The Royal Agricultural Society of WA is thrilled with so many new entries that will continue the 175-year-old tradition.

A full week of judging, Trophy judging, Exhibitor Tasting and Awards Presentation is taking place at the Claremont Showground starting 26 August and culminating in the Awards being presented at the Wilkinson Gallery on 31 August.

Some of 2017's award-winning favourites including Flametree Wines and Houghton's will be back, bringing new vintages and flavour combinations. And with the new flavours comes new judges, including Chief Judge Corrina Wright from Oliver's Tiranga Vineyard, Panel Leader Trina Smith from Pernod Rickard and Senior Judge Toni Paterson wine writer and master of wine.
