## How to create a Google Form



- Do not forget to click on "require" for making each question mandatory.




- We suggest you to ask for the guest Full name and phone number. You can add an option to add other guests into the same form.





- Upload your own header image (or select one of the pictures included in Google Forms), a theme colour, a background colour and a font style.


- Once you have finished editing your template, you can configure the settings.

  - Remove all the other options if you don't want people to require people to sign in in Google for answering the form, or leave it if you prefer this option.
  - Click on "Save".




- Before publishing the form, you can preview it. A new window will open showing you the overview of your form.




- Click on "Send" to publish your form.



- Finally, click on the link option. We will use this URL for creating a QR code for making easier the registration for your guests.




- The form responses will be automatically saved into your Google Account. Simply visit the form page and click on "Responses".




## How to create a QR code


- Now that we have our form ready, we can create the QR code that we will print for our venue. Visit this page for creating a free QR code: <https://www.qr-code-generator.com/>
- At the QR code website, select the first option "Opens the url after scanning".



- Copy the URL link from Google Forms and paste it here.



- Once you enter your link, the QR code will be generated. Click on Download JPG for downloading your QR code.



- Now that you have your QR code, you only need to paste it into a Word page and display it at your venue. You can use [this Word template](#) that we've created for you and simply copy the QR code into the blank space.
