Genuine OEM parts and componentry are engineered and refined over time to fit with specific truck models, thus delivering not only compatibility, but also optimal performance, efficiency and safety.

Acquiring and maintaining a truck is a significant responsibility and monetary investment, and a major priority for any business, big or small, should be to extend the ongoing value and lifespan of the truck. The use of genuine parts can contribute to reducing whole-of-life costs, as they are often covered by a manufacturer's warranty.

For Isuzu Trucks owners, respecifying with the recommended Michelin tyres will deliver a broad spectrum of additional efficiencies including:

- Fuel economy Trucks fitted with Michelin original equipment tyres typically consume less fuel, contributing to a smoother ride on the road.
- Combat incorrect tyre pressure rolling resistance from tyres can contribute
 up to 30 per cent of the force opposing a truck (compared to 20 per cent in
 passenger cars) also affecting overall fuel consumption.
- Wear and tear correctly specified, fitted and aligned tyres should wear evenly.
- Rotation frequency quality tyres may not need to be rotated as frequently, saving money on labour costs and minimising the time your vehicle spends off the road.

Whether you own a single truck, a few, or run a larger fleet, the costs associated with tyre choice can quickly add up. Respecifying with the correct Michelin tyres for your Isuzu truck keeps the power in your hands, allowing for a more precise, less costly, and safer driving experience.
