Who is it For?

To be eligible for jobactive, you must receive income support payments such as Newstart, Youth Allowance or Parenting Payments and have mutual obligation requirements. If you meet these requirements, you can be referred to jobactive through Centrelink. If you don't meet these requirements, you may be able to join the program as a volunteer job seeker.

How it Works

Most job seekers are referred to jobactive with MTC through Centrelink. You will then meet with a jobactive consultant and together you'll develop a Job Plan tailored to your needs and goals.

- Find new job openings and opportunities
- Learn how to prepare for an interview and best present your skills and experience
- Build your self-confidence
