A Traineeship in Early Childhood Education & Care allows new entrant and existing workers to gain accreditation for skills and knowledge developed on the job and through training and mentoring. Content is designed in line with the Care Services National Regulations and National Quality Standard and can be further customised to meet employer needs.

### Is this course for you?

Students/trainees may be new entrant or existing workers in roles such as family daycare workers, early childhood educators, playgroup supervisors or childhood educator assistants.

There are no entry requirements for this qualification. MTC recommends that students have language, literacy and numeracy skills at ACSF Level 3.

This course is available to all students under the Smart and Skilled initiative of NSW State Training. To be eligible for funding, you must:

- Be an Australian citizen, permanent resident or humanitarian visa holder
- Be aged 15 years or older
- Live or work in New South Wales
- Have left school and have no previous qualifications at Certificate IV or higher

### Course structure

MTC offers this course as a Traineeship, which combines workplace training and assessment with online learning. Training support is provided throughout to ensure students have the greatest chance of successful completion.

This course takes 12–18 months to complete and requires students to complete 18 units of

competency as per the Training Package. It is comprised of 15 core and 3 elective units.
