Is Smart, Skilled & Hired Youth Employment for you?

To be eligible for the Smart, Skilled & Hired program you need to be:

- Aged 15–24
- Unemployed or underemployed
- Not receiving unemployment benefits

You may also be eligible if you are receiving unemployment benefits or participate in another government program such as Juvenile Justice, Out of Home Care or Social Housing.

About Smart, Skilled & Hired Youth Employment

The NSW Government-funded Smart, Skilled & Hired program is designed to help young people seeking work, or who have a part-time job that doesn't offer many hours.

You'll work one-on-one with a dedicated Youth Employment Coach to identify your work goals, then create a plan for achieving them based on your interests, skills and learning needs. Your plan might include education or training, work experience or support from community services.

Together with your coach you'll track progress and celebrate your wins. Outside of these one-on-one mentoring sessions we'll stay in touch via email, phone, sms and social media to make sure you're well supported.

You may also be eligible to receive financial assistance for expenses like work clothing, training costs and transport... Whatever you need to get Smart, Skilled & Hired!

In 2017/18 MTC Australia supported 1,053 young people towards securing employment with Smart, Skilled & Hired.
