

**ORM 10
OFF-LICENCE**

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **C B & D WILLIAMS LIMITED** is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 4 Freswick Street Blenheim, Marlborough District and known as "**NEW WORLD BLENHEIM**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol, as a sample of up to 35ml, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises unless it contains no more than 15% ethanol by volume measured at 20 C and is:
 - (i) Beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) Mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) Fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine (however that product may be described in the standard); or
 - (iv) Grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine (however) that product may be described in the standard); or
 - (v) A food flavouring prepared for culinary purposes that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (c) Alcohol may be sold or delivered on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm
- (d) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (e) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible sale of alcohol
- (f) The licensee when conducting phone, mail, internet sales (remote sales) must ensure that all requirements under Section 59 of the Act relating remote sales are complied with.
- (g) **The only area delineated on the plan supplied with the application (CM record number 2614260) is the permitted area for display and promotion of alcohol.**

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from the carpark off Freswick Street is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) either-
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued;
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either-
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed: or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.



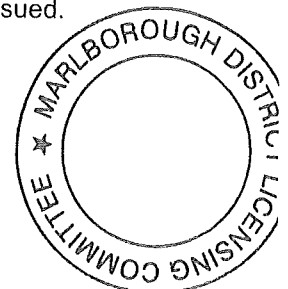
