

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64 Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

**PURSUANT** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **LEE FAMILY GROCERS LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **9 LANARK STREET, BALCLUTHA** and known as "**NEW WORLD BALCLUTHA**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made –
  - i. on the premises; or
  - ii. From grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated:
- (c) No alcohol may be sold other than -
  - i. beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer' or
  - ii. mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
  - iii. fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
  - iv. a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (d) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday 8.00am to 8.30pm**
- (e) Drinking water must be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (f) A certificated manager is to be on duty at all times the premises are open for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.
- (g) The only area delineated on the attached plan is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol.
- (h) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to minors, intoxicated or prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to minors and intoxicated persons.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

In terms of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013, the sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in or from the premises situated at **9 Lanark Street, Balclutha** that are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the **Clutha District Licensing Committee** on 12 January 2026.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed in the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering **each** principal entrance. The entrance from the carpark is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) either
  - (i) Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either -
  - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
