

Off-Licence

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of
Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), W D McLean Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 43 Waterloo Road, Lower Hutt and known as "Hutt City New World", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) no alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day;
- (b) no alcohol may be sold other than -
 - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted
- (c) alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm
- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure compulsory conditions of sections 112, 113 and 114 of the Act relating to the display and promotion of alcohol in a single area plan submitted with the application:
 - i. alcohol must only be sold and supplied on the premises in accordance with the single area plan submitted and finalised on 21st February 2018
 - ii. the only area delineated on the attached plan described in shading is the permitted single area for the display and promotion of alcohol.
 - iii. The identified single area must not be reconfigured or rearranged unless a variation/change to the single area is applied for and approved.
 - iv. No display or promotion of, or advertisement for, a product of alcohol shall occur outside of the prescribed single area of the premises.
 - v. No display or promotion of, or advertisement for, a product that is not alcohol shall occur inside the described alcohol single area of the premises.
- (e) the following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: The Licensee or manager must ensure that:
 - i. alcohol is not sold to intoxicated persons,
 - ii. statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors are observed at all times and evidence of age documents are requested where necessary.
 - iii. signs clearly stating the above requirements be placed at all points of sale.
- (f) drinking water is to be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises from the following location: The sampling location within the alcohol area
- (g) the only permitted area (as delineated on the attached plan) for the display and promotion of alcohol is: the Northeast corner from the entrance of the premises

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either -
 - i. until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either-
 - i. until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. if it has been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

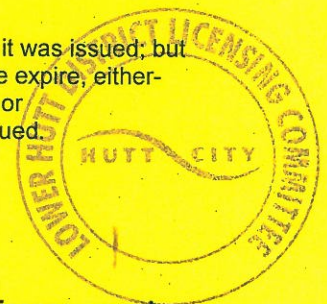
