

## NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF LICENCE

Section 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

TO: MCW Supermarkets Limited

Licence 46/OFF/00092/2015 replacing licence 046/OFF/0004/11

THE Off Licence in respect of the premises situated at 2 Walton Leigh Avenue Porirua City Centre, Porirua and known as the "Porirua New World" is renewed.

The present conditions of the licence continue to apply subject to the following changes:

- 1) no alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1:00 pm on Anzac Day.
- 2) no alcohol may be sold other than—
  - i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
  - ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
  - iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
  - iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
  - v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- 3) alcohol may be sold or delivered only on the following days and during the following hours:
  - Monday to Sunday between 7:00 am and 10:00 pm.
- 4) the entire premises will be designated as "Undesignated" as outlined in the floor plan approved on the 11<sup>th</sup> November 2011 and includes the single area plans submitted with the renewal application, where alcohol is displayed and promoted.
- 5) the following steps must be taken to ensure that the compulsory conditions of Sections 112, 113, and 114 of the Act relating to the display and promotion of alcohol in a single area in the premises are observed:
  - i) alcohol must only be sold and supplied on the premises in accordance with the single area plan premises submitted with the application.
  - ii) the only area delineated on the attached plan described in shading, is the permitted single area for the display and promotion of alcohol:
  - iii) the shaded single area must not be reconfigured or rearranged unless a variation/change to the single area is applied for.
  - iv) no display or promotion of, or advertisement for, a product of alcohol shall occur outside of the described single area of the premises.
  - v) no display or promotion of, or advertisement for, a product that is not alcohol shall occur inside the described alcohol single area of the premises.
- 6) the following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - i) a restriction of sale or supply of alcohol to persons under the age of 18 years of age.
  - ii) evidence of age documents will be requested where appropriate.
  - iii) display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- 7) No alcohol promotions encouraging the rapid consumption of alcohol or the consumption of an excessive volume of alcohol will be either initiated or conducted on the premises.
- 8) the holder of a manager's certificate or a properly notified manager shall be on duty and on the premises at all times alcohol is sold.
- 9) a Host Responsibility Policy shall be displayed and maintained at all points of sale.
- 10) the licensee must ensure all staff understand the conditions of this licence and receive training in their policy and in their responsibilities and obligations under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- 11) when free samples of alcohol are being provided, the licensee must provide and promote free drinking water.
- 12) The licensee must ensure at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it is issued, is displayed inside the premises, so as to be easily read by people using the premises.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence continues in force—

- until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before it would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it is renewed.

The period for which the licence is renewed is 3 years expiring on 11 November 2018.
