

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 18 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Young Supermarkets Limited Licence Number 45/OFF/004/2018

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Young Supermarkets Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at Kapiti Landing Park, 159 Kapiti Road, Paraparaumu and known as New World Kapiti, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) no alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day;
- (b) no alcohol may be sold other than —
 - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (c) alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:


Monday to Sunday - 7am to 10pm
- (d) the whole of the premises is **undesignated**;
- (e) the **single alcohol area** (the only permitted area for the promotion and display of alcohol) is demarcated in yellow on the attached plan received on 24 August 2015, and encompasses the area defined by the wooden style vinyl floor covering laid in a convex shape, and in the case of the chiller unit on the west wall, defined by the different paint colour on the portion of the canopy above the display cabinet;
- (f) advertising signage within the single alcohol area is restricted to A4 size;
- (g) signage related to detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons must be displayed at each point of sale;
- (h) a copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance, the principal entrance is defined as the entrance from the car park.

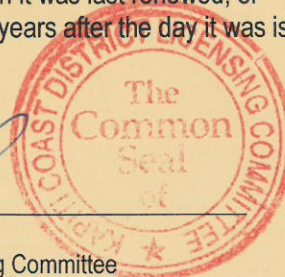
Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
