

**OFF-LICENCE**

Sections 17, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012(the Act), **Bay Stone Supermarkets Limited** is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **308 Aickin Road, Whangamata** and known as **New World Whangamata**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

**CONDITIONS**

The licence is subject to the conditions listed as follows:

- a) Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:  
**Monday to Sunday from 7:00am to 9.00pm**
- b) No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- c) No alcohol may be sold other than –
  - i. beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
  - ii. mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
  - iii. fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
  - iv. grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
  - v. a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted;
- e) While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
- f) The Licensee must have available for purchase on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- g) A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- h) The **'single alcohol area'** for the premises is as described on the plan attached at Appendix 'A' to this decision.
  - i. No alcohol is displayed, promoted or advertised outside the single alcohol area;  
and
  - ii. No products other than alcohol, low-alcohol and non-alcoholic beer, wine or mead are displayed, promoted or advertised inside the single alcohol area.
- i) The Licensee must display:
  - i. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
  - ii. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
  - iii. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance.

**THE LICENSED PREMISES**


The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in or from the premises generally. The premises, situated at **308 Aickin Road, Whangamata**, is more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Thames Coromandel District Licensing Committee on 12 April 2018.

**DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
