## Notice of Renewal of Off Licence

Section 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **JJACH HOLDINGS LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at 12 JOCELYN STREET, TE PUKE, and known as TE PUKE NEW WORLD, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

### **CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday 7:00am to 10:00pm**
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (d) No alcohol may be sold other than—
  - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
  - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
  - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
  - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
  - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
  - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons, at each entry and adjacent to every point of sale.
- (f) Only the area delineated on the attached (displayed) plan and the configuration shown, is a permitted area and configuration for the display and promotion of alcohol.

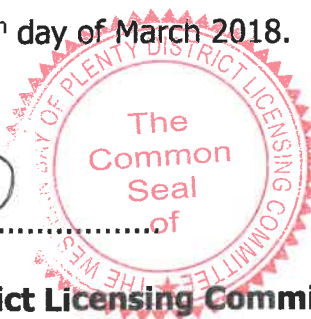
