

Notice of renewal of licence Off-licence

Section 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



Licence number: 13/OFF/003/2018

To Woody Ventures Limited

The off-licence in respect of the premises situated at 79 Thames Street Morrinsville and known as Morrinsville New World is renewed.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) no alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day:
- (b) no alcohol may be sold other than—
 - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (c) alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 9.00pm
- (d) the only area delineated on the attached plan (**06-G1 12 June 2017**) is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol:
- (e) while alcohol is being provided free as a sample drinking water to be provided free from the same location
- (f) the licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

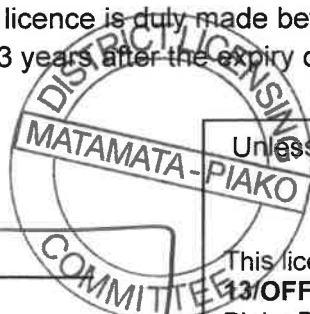
Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- a) until its expiry date detailed below; but
- b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the expiry date.
