

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **The Local Grocer Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 8-10 Memorial Avenue, Kaikohe, Far North District and known as **Kaikohe New World**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) **No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.**
- b) No alcohol may be sold other than:
 - beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - a food flavoring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- c) **Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 7.00 am to 9.00 pm**
- d) Only the area delineated on the plan provided and date stamped 4 October 2017 is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol.
- e) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises and signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.
- f) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - **Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.**
 - **Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons, at each entry and adjacent to every point of sale.**

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in or from the premises generally. The premises, situated 8-10 Memorial Avenue, Kaikohe, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Far North District Licensing Committee on 4 October 2017.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Merino Place carpark is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) **either -**
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; **or**
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued;
- but-**
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, **either**
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; **or**
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
