

OFF Licence

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Duffields Foodmarket Ltd** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **60-72 High Street South Carterton** and known as **Carterton New World**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.

Alcohol may be sold on or delivered from the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied free as a sample for consumption only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00 pm

The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol: While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.

The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

The premises are designated as **undesigned**.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE

Copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance is from High Street South, is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

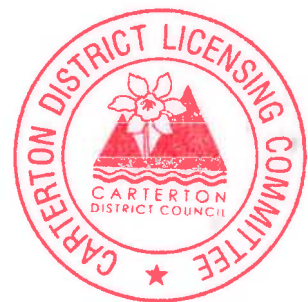
Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—
