

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), S P Supermarket Ltd (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **NEW WORLD SUPERMARKET, Whitby Mall, 69 A Discovery Drive, Whitby, Porirua City 5024** and known as **New World Whitby** to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1) No alcohol is to be sold other than
 - i. Beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - ii. Mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - iii. Fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine (however that product may be described in the standard); or
 - iv. Grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine (however that product may be described in the standard); or
 - v. A food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking dilutedAppropriate New Zealand food standard, in relation to any kind of alcohol, means the standard for alcohol of that kind that is for the time being in force under the Food Act 2014.
- 2) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1:00 pm on Anzac Day to any person.
- 3) The licensee will not break down packaged mainstream beer and wine products, including damaged packages, imported high alcohol mainstream beer products and will not sell such beers singularly or in separate parts not intended for sale. This restriction does not apply to individual hand crafted expensive beer in single bottles/cans or multi serve size 330ml or higher.
- 4) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday between 7:00 am and 10:00 pm
- 5) The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
 - i. Evidence of age documents will be requested where appropriate.
 - ii. Implement and maintain the host responsibility policy submitted with the application.
- 6) The area of premises where alcohol can be sold, supplied and consumed will be designated 'undesigned' as per attached plans submitted with the application.
- 7) The following steps must be taken to ensure compulsory conditions of Sections 112, 113 and 114 of the Act relating to the display and promotion of alcohol;
 - i. Alcohol must only be sold and supplied on the premises in accordance with the single area plan submitted with the application and dated 7 December 2017.
 - ii. No display or promotion of, or advertisement for, a product of alcohol shall occur outside of the prescribed single area of the premises.
 - iii. No display or advertisement for, a product of alcohol will be bigger than A4 advertising. This excludes the normal "Beer and Wine" signs above the prescribed single area which will be the same font, size and colour of the other signs in the store i.e. "Delicatessen", "Fruit and Vegetables", etc.
 - iv. No display or promotion of, or advertisement for, a product that is not alcohol shall occur inside the described alcohol single area of the premises.
 - v. Renovations currently planned for the Single Alcohol Area, must be completed no later than 1 November 2018, as per the draft building plan timeline submitted to the District Licensing Committee on 7 February.
- 8) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises are observed:
 - i. The licensee will ensure all staff will be trained in their responsibilities under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012; AND the licensee will ensure all staff is aware of their legal obligations and responsibilities under the Act, including compliance with the conditions of this licence and their Host Responsibility Policy.
 - ii. The licensee must ensure at all times a copy of the licence, together with a statement of all conditions subject to which it was issued, is displayed inside the premises, so as to be easily read by people using the premises.
 - iii. A sign shall be prominently displayed inside the premises, which identifies by name the manager on duty or of the person responsible for the management of the sale and supply of alcohol under the licence.
- 9) The holder of a manager's certificate or a properly notified manager shall be on duty and on the premises at all times alcohol is sold.
- 10) Display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- 11) Drinking water must be freely available and displayed whenever alcohol is being supplied by way of complimentary tastings.
- 12) A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport and staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed and viewable to customers.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
