

# Off Licence

Section 17 to 20, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



007/OFF/3092/2020

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Wells Lamb Supermarket 3 Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **25 Bowen Street Waiuku Auckland**, and known as **New World Waiuku**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

## CONDITIONS

The conditions of the licence are as follows:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day
- (b) **Alcohol may be sold on the premises only on the following days and during the following hours:  
Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm**
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers **immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises**
- (d) No alcohol may be sold other than—
  - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
  - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
  - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
  - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
  - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
- (e) No intoxicated persons may be allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
- (f) Appropriate signage regarding the restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons must be prominently displayed adjacent to every point of sale.
- (g) Only the area delineated on the floor plan authenticated by the Inspector on 9 June 2020, and the configuration shown, is a permitted area and configuration for the display and promotion of alcohol. A copy of the plan is to be displayed either alongside this licence or be available for viewing at a point of sale.
- (h) The whole of the premises is undesignated.

## DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
  - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

**This licence expires at the close of 12 June 2021 unless renewed.**
