

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



Great Grocers Limited Licence Number 45/OFF/797/2025

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), Great Grocers Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 155-163 Main Highway, Otaki and known as New World Otaki, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance from the car park.
2. Alcohol is only permitted to be sold, supplied or delivered on or from the premises authorised by the licence.
3. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
4. No alcohol may be sold other than —
 - (i) beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - (ii) mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - (iii) fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - (iv) grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - (v) a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted.
5. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday - 7am to 11pm

6. The whole of the premises is **undesignated**.
7. The licensed premises situated at 155-163 Main Highway, Otaki are more precisely identified as outlined in the plan date stamped as approved by the District Licensing Committee on 21 November 2025 displayed alongside this licence and held on DLC file OFF797.
8. The **single alcohol area** (the only permitted area for the promotion and display of alcohol) is defined on the attached plan, approved on 21 November 2025, and encompasses both sides of the third aisle in from the north wall, with no outward facing end of aisle displays of alcohol.
9. No single sales of beer, except for craft beer, in containers of 500mls or less in volume.
10. All deliveries of alcohol must be signed for by a person aged 18 years or older. Signs of intoxication on the part of the recipient would result in non-delivery.
11. A properly appointed Certificated, or Acting or Temporary, Manager must be on duty, at or nearby the point of sale, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
12. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and to intoxicated persons.
13. The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the safe and responsible consumption of alcohol, and minimising alcohol related harm.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

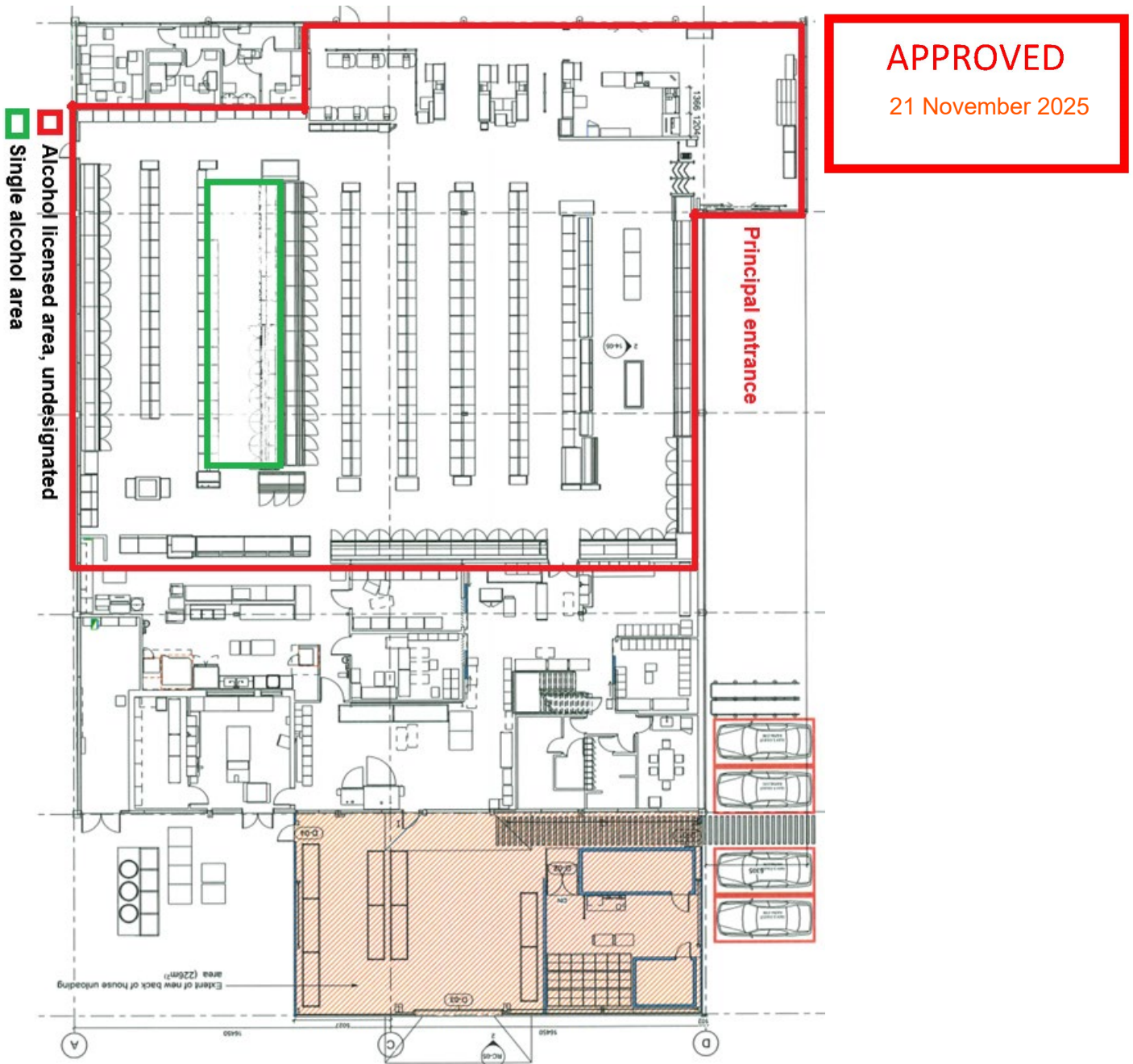


Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on:

Undertakings by licensee:

Advertising

- *Promotional and pricing signage in the single alcohol area is limited to A4 size.*

Single sales, as part of a commitment to responsible alcohol sales, I agree that:

- *Beer in containers of 500mls or less in volume will not be sold in quantities of less than four bottles/cans (except for craft beer). Excessive discount will not be applied to the four pack.*

Delivery of restricted goods:

- *Alcohol is considered a restricted good. We are unable to leave restricted goods unattended at an address, and if there is no one aged 18 years or older to receive the delivery, we will not leave it. Alcohol purchases must be received by someone who is aged 18 years or older. In order to take the delivery, valid and current identification must be shown to the person/s delivering the goods. If the deliverer considers the person receiving the delivery to be intoxicated, the alcohol will not be delivered. This identification must include the following: Full name, Date of Birth, Photo and Signature.*
- *When we engage a courier company to make our deliveries, we will only use a company that can provide sufficient reassurance that their drivers will always adhere to the requirement to obtain a signature and proof of ID showing that the recipient is over 18 years of age. A signed written agreement between the courier and applicant will be provided to the tri-agencies.*
