SURROUND STKS – NEVER TALK – Race 7 No.7 (Randwick)

Weaved her way through the field coming from near last in the Group 2 Light Fingers Stakes to just miss and meets many of those horses in this event.

BEST – COLETTE – Race 6 No.7 (Randwick)

We have a new superstar of the turf in my opinion. Her Golden Eagle win at the end of last prep was huge but she showed she has returned even better by taking out the Apollo Stakes first-up.

VALUE – TO THE MOON ALICE – Race 1 No.6 (Flemington)

Had no luck on debut at The Valley when she found no room at a vital stage. She showed her toughness when she picked back up and found the line really well. Jamie Kah will give her every opportunity.

LAY – BUFFALO RIVER – Race 6 No.11 (Flemington)

Has a good overall record but has failed to win at his last five attempts now. Looked the winner first-up but was swamped late and this is a much tougher task.

BACKED – MUNTASEERA – Race 5 No.10 (Flemington)

Muntaseera trialled exceptionally well leading into this first-up assignment and the punters did not miss her in early betting. She opened \$9 and has been backed all the way into \$5.

SURROUND STKS – THERMOSPHERE – Race 7 No.10 (Randwick)

Had an extra run which is a plus and forced to do the chasing in the Light Fingers Stakes. She stayed at 1200m there and much better suited at 1400m with the track rated soft.

BEST – ICEBATH – Race 5 No.7 (Randwick)

Draws to camp on the speed provided by Sweet Deal, Helga and Bam's On Fire. Handles the wet and 1400m suits at her second run in. Should be in the finish again.

VALUE – SING A LOVE SONG – Race 2 No.4 (Randwick)

In each of his three starts to date he has wanted to find the line and think 1200m will suit him down to the ground. Rocket Tiger and Remarque form is good enough for this.

LAY – CRIADERAS – Race 4 No.10 (Randwick)

Has a stack of talent but he's going to be giving them all a decent start here on a wet track, which isn't the best scenario. Think he should be a longer price.

BACKED – TYCOON HUMMA – Race 1 No.5 (Flemington)

Our customers are all over this filly that won impressively at Bendigo two weeks ago. We went up with \$3 and that was quickly shortened into \$2.80. She's now a \$2.50 chance.



Matthew Steed – Bet365

SURROUND STKS – MONTEFILLIA – Race 7 No.1 (Randwick)

Class filly resuming here fitted with two recent trials. Will be giving some of these a start but think the solid tempo and the sting out of the ground will help her. Expect her to be steaming home.

BEST – WATER DOVE – Race 1 No.6 (Randwick)

Shaped well at only her third start when a narrow second last time. That form has been confirmed since and think she might have a bit more upside than most of her rivals here.

VALUE – DEFIANT DANCER – Race 4 No.4 (Flemington)

Comes here off a break after a successful campaign last time. Loves the straight track and comes in well after the claim. Think he represents great each-way value in this.

LAY – GREAT HOUSE – Race 8 No.10 (Randwick)

Think there is a fair bit more depth here and with there not being as much speed on paper as last start, he is worth betting around at the short quote.

BACKED – FOUR MOVES AHEAD – Race 3 No.5 (Randwick)

Impressive on the wet track on debut, albeit a while back now. Been fitted for this with a strong trial win and the punters have reacted. She's been \$3.20 into \$2.80.

SURROUND STKS – DAME GISELLE – Race 7 No.3 (Randwick)

Dame Giselle's record speaks for itself and she was strong through the line first-up in the Inglis Sprint. The tempo looks genuine which should suit her run-on style.

BEST – LAVERROD – Race 4 No.3 (Flemington)

WA galloper that did a great job at his first run down the straight, just getting run down late. Damien Oliver should control the race from the widest draw and prove too good.

VALUE – VALAC – Race 8 No.1 (Murray Bridge)

Much improved effort last start and since had a hurdle trial to bring him on fitness wise. Draws to get the run of the race and gets the in-form Jessica Eaton in the saddle.

LAY – SHAQUERO – Race 2 No.1 (Randwick)

Normally the Breeders Plate and Magic Millions are great guides but neither looked that strong this year. Meets some promising types and barrier one could be awkward.

BACKED – MUNTASEERA – Race 5 No.10 (Flemington)

No shortage of supporters after her trial. We opened with \$7 on Wednesday and that has been backed all the way into \$5. Will probably start shorter as well.



James Early – Palmerbet

SURROUND STKS – LA MEXICANA – Race 7 No.9 (Randwick)

This filly just looks to be a winner and the form stacks up from Malicorne beaten a nose last week at Caulfield. Step up here to taking on the Sydney fillies but think she will feature in the finish.

BEST – FABERGINO – Race 5 No.2 (Flemington)

Was a really good run in a hot Group 1 last start at the same track and distance. That was her only defeat at the 1000m down the straight and this is a big drop-in class.

VALUE – I'M TELLING YA – Race 4 No.7 (Flemington)

Was an impressive win at this track last time out and should only improve into Saturday's test. Will be flying late and am happy to take the big each-way price.

LAY – ROCKETING BY – Race 8 No.3 (Flemington)

Rocketing By is having his first go down the straight and has barrier one. Looks a tough ask so we're happy to be against at the skinny odds on offer.

BACKED – THE HARROVIAN – Race 3 No.2 (Flemington)

The cult hero of Queensland has had a stack of support to salute after his heroics up north. Has been \$5 into \$3.50 with us and should be tough to beat.

SURROUND STKS – LA MEXICANA – Race 7 No.3 (Randwick)

Looks well suited third-up boasting race fitness over some of her rivals. Looking for the 1400m now, maps sweetly, handles any cut in the ground and gets the services of the returning Tom Marquand.

BEST – VERRY ELLEEGANT – Race 6 No.9 (Rosehill)

Unsuited first-up in a slowly run affair where she missed the kick and overraced. Looks a good platform stepping to the mile and she gets her favourable track conditions.

VALUE – BAM'S ON FIRE – Race 5 No.5 (Randwick)

Hidden run first-up where she wasn't ridden to effect yet still recorded the fastest closing sectionals of the race in restricted room. Maps much more positively in this event and will appreciate the extra ground.

LAY – SHE'S ALL CLASS – Race 3 No.1 (Randwick)

Not convinced on the substance of her form having lacked any strong figures in her three starts. Couple that with the horror draw, she looks set a task on Saturday. Happy to oppose at the current odds.

BACKED – CRIADERAS – Race 4 No.10 (Randwick)

Always a well backed commodity is this horse, and the punters are keen to be with him first-up. Has been \$6 into \$4.20 and wouldn't surprise to see them go on with it.

Tom Hackett – Ladbrokes

SURROUND STKS – NEVER TALK – Race 7 No.7 (Randwick)

Her run in the Light Fingers Stakes was excellent and she ran the fastest closing sectionals of the day. Barrier seven is ideal for her and she has scored two wins from as many starts on a heavy track.

BEST – SHAQUERO – Race 2 No.1 (Randwick)

There was plenty to like about the way that he put away his rivals in the Magic Millions 2YO Classic and this race is no tougher. Barrier one is ideal and the wet track shouldn't be a problem.

VALUE – FIFTY STARS – Race 6 No.1 (Flemington)

He returned to the races with a fairly plain effort in the Apollo Stakes, but he should improve second-up. All of his best form has been produced at Flemington and the step-up to 1600m is ideal.

LAY – BUFFALO RIVER – Race 6 No.11 (Flemington)

I'm not sure if there is a more overrated horse in the country. Had plenty of chances during the spring and failed to deliver at black-type level. I think the market has overreacted.

BACKED – FOUR MOVES AHEAD – Race 3 No.5 (Randwick)

Was scratched last weekend, but punters remain confident that she can make it two wins from as many race starts. She has been \$3.30 into \$2.70 and looks set to start even shorter.



Clint Wallis – Neds

SURROUND STKS – DAME GISELLE – Race 7 No.3 (Randwick)

Settled towards the back first-up in the Inglis Sprint and looked a chance of winning before peaking on her run. Boasts a perfect record second-up and the step up to 1400m looks ideal.

BEST – FABERGINO – Race 5 No.2 (Flemington)

Two impressive wins over this track and trip before tackling the Lightning Stakes where she performed admirably. Should get every chance in front again.

VALUE – CHAILLOT – Race 9 No.11 (Flemington)

Resuming with an unblemished first-up record. Has a perfect record from two goes at this track and distance as well. Was less than a length off winning a Group 1 in the spring and can give this a shake.

LAY – ROCKETING BY – Race 8 No.3 (Flemington)

Has won all three starts this time in, including his most recent run in the Inglis Sprint. Think he's come up under the odds this week dropping back to 1100m and not sure he'll be suited in gate one.

BACKED – TYCOON HUMMA – Race 1 No.5 (Flemington)

Well backed on debut and was most impressive in winning by more than two lengths. Punters are happy to back up here, backing her in from \$2.90 to \$2.60.



Jared Timms – Betstar

SURROUND STKS – LA MEXICANA – Race 7 No.9 (Randwick)

Stamped herself as a runner to follow in the late stages of spring and has recorded two wins from as many starts back this time, including the Group 3 Kevin Hayes Stakes. Ready to peak third-up.

BEST – GREAT HOUSE – Race 8 No.10 (Rosehill)

Put paid to them in Benchmark 78 company last time out and has been kept up to the mark with a trial. Gets in with a small weight and with even luck, should just be winning again.

VALUE – SANSOM – Race 3 No.4 (Flemington)

Has been freshened since finished a midfield in the Magic Millions Sprint and always races well off a break. Is a winner at the grade, track and trip and has found form around some quality gallopers.

LAY – VERRY ELLEEGANT – Race 6 No.6 (Randwick)

Enters this race off the back of an impressive win in the Eskimo Prince Stakes but faces a tougher task and definitely keeps his best performances for Randwick. Others have more appeal in the market.

BACKED – ZAKAT – Race 9 No.5 (Randwick)

Returned a pleasing effort to only just miss down the straight at Flemington when resuming and tends to enjoy sharp improvement second-up. Has continued to receive big interest all week.



Wayne Symons – Unibet

SURROUND STKS – MONTEFILLIA – Race 7 No.1 (Randwick)

The track conditions on Saturday suggest to me that this filly is the way to go. Has a great first-up record, loves the track and the wet is just ideal - can see her getting over the top of her rivals here.

BEST – SWEET DEAL – Race 4 No.5 (Randwick)

She looks to get total control of this race on speed with Nash Rawiller aboard and has a tremendous fresh record. She'll enjoy the cut in the ground and will be adding a Group 2 win to her resume.

VALUE – REALM OF FLOWERS – Race 8 No.8 (Randwick)

Didn't have the best run when she resumed and should have finished much closer. Will appreciate the extra trip and her second-up record is good. Value around the double figure mark.

LAY – SHAQUERO – Race 2 No.1 (Randwick)

This isn't the grand final for this colt and he bumps into some handy types. Not sure the inside gate and wet track are ideal and I couldn't possibly entertain him at his current quote around \$2.50.

BACKED – FOUR MOVES AHEAD – Race 3 No.5 (Randwick)

This promising filly from the was impressive winning on debut and the punters have warmed to her continuing that winning run. She has been well supported into \$2.70 from a high of \$3.40 with us.



Matthew Clingly – TopSport

SURROUND STKS – DAME GISELLE – Race 7 No.3 (Randwick)

Ridden further back first-up off a hot speed and might have peaked on her run. I'm expecting her to settle much closer this time and with a perfect record second-up, she'll be hard to beat.

BEST – SHAQUERO – Race 2 No.1 (Randwick)

Looked good in winning the Magic Millions in January. Tuned up for this with a trial win earlier this month. Should control the speed and with the most race experience, should be too good for them here.

VALUE – SOFIE'S GOLD CLASS – Race 8 No.5 (Sunshine Coast)

Was a big effort last start when wide and kept coming on the line. Seems to really like the Sunshine Coast track and add in the chance of rain - he looks well over the odds.

LAY – THE HARROVIAN – Race 3 No.2 (Flemington)

Been a winning machine in Queensland but think this could be another step further again. Will need everything to go his way and happy to be against him this time.

BACKED – MUNTASEERA – Race 5 No.10 (Flemington)

The punters have been ruthless in backing this Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained filly. She has been \$7 into \$4.80 at this stage and may shorten further.



James Thomas – Palmerbet

SURROUND STKS – DAME GISELLE – Race 7 No.3 (Randwick)

Was unable to cross them first-up and had to be snagged back which cost her the race. She ran strongly from the back and will be fitter for the run. The extra 200m looks more suitable.

BEST – OLE KIRK – Race 7 No.1 (Flemington)

Slightly disappointing last start but can hit back here. Kerrin McEvoy will take him back to last from barrier 15 and he will have plenty of time to balance him up over the 1600m at Flemington.

VALUE – REALM OF FLOWERS – Race 8 No.8 (Randwick)

Slow beginning left her with little hope first-up but she ran on OK and the extra 200m is a positive. Looks to get a soft run from barrier two and has won at Group 3 level before.

LAY – TIBETAN – Race 8 No.4 (Murray Bridge)

One win 15 starts and that was on a heavy (8) deck. Rarely runs a bad race but just always seems to find one better and looks well under the odds at \$2.60. Happy to take him on as a short-priced favourite.

BACKED – HILAL – Race 2 No.6 (Randwick)

Winner on debut for the Hawkes stable and the punters think he can repeat the dose after backing him in from an opening quote of \$5.50. Should be right in the finish.
