Epson Printer Keeps Disconnecting: WiFi Dropout Fix Guide

If your Epson printer keeps disconnecting, unstable WiFi, router conflicts, outdated firmware, ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 DHCP changes may be to blame.

Start by assigning a static IP address to the printer to prevent frequent drops.

Ensure the printer is connected to a 2.4GHz network—many Epson models struggle with 5GHz.

Move the printer closer to the router and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] update firmware to improve network stability.

If Epson disconnects after sleep mode, disable power-saving features in the printer menu.

Reinstall Epson drivers and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] reconnect the printer using Epson Connect⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 WiFi Setup Wizard.
