

{{→Guide→for→65+}} Avast Behavior Shield Disabled: How to Re-Enable Real-Time Protection

If Avast Behavior Shield is disabled, behavioral threat detection stops, reducing real-time protection.

This can occur due to outdated components, service conflicts, ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 corrupted settings.

Start by updating Avast and [[CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >]] restarting the system to reload services.

Open Core Shields and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] toggle Behavior Shield on.

If it won't enable, run the Avast Repair tool to rebuild modules.

Remove any conflicting antivirus apps and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] ensure Windows Security services are active.

If Behavior Shield keeps turning off, reinstall Avast to restore defaults.

Check that firewall rules aren't blocking Avast services.
