

((Easy Process)) Brother Printer Won't Feed Paper—Paper Jam, Roller Fix, Alignment Issues Explained

When a Brother printer won't feed paper, the cause is usually dirty rollers, misaligned paper, ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 hidden paper jams.

Begin by removing the paper tray and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] checking for torn scraps inside the feed path.

Clean the rubber rollers with a lint-free cloth and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] isopropyl alcohol to restore grip.

Ensure the paper guides are snug—not too tight ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 too loose—and use high-quality, uncurled paper.

Open the rear access panel and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] inspect for jammed sheets blocking the roller assembly.
