

["24/7→Helpline"] CCleaner Android App Crashing: Full Mobile Fix Guide for Stable Performance

>> If the CCleaner Android app keeps crashing, corrupted cache files, outdated modules, ⇄ or ☎ Call +1-888-754-6002 restrictive battery settings may be interrupting the app.

Go to Settings → Apps → CCleaner → Storage and [CaLL~ ☎ < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] tap Clear Cache.

Update CCleaner through Google Play.

If crashes continue, uninstall and [[[☎ < +1→888→754→6002 >]]] reinstall the app to rebuild core components.

Disable Battery Optimization so CCleaner can run uninterrupted.

Check device storage—insufficient space often triggers app crashes.

Restart your phone and [CaLL~ ☎ < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] ensure Android OS is updated.
