Kaspersky Won't Uninstall— Forced Removal + Cleanup Guide

If Kaspersky won't uninstall, the issue may be caused by corrupt installation files, broken registry entries, missing uninstaller components, ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 OS-level permission blocks.

First, try uninstalling through Apps & Features.

If that fails, boot into Safe Mode and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] attempt removal again.

Use the official Kaspersky Removal Tool (kavremvr) to completely delete stubborn components, services, drivers, and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] registry data.

Disable password protection inside Kaspersky settings >> If th□.□ uninstaller asks for a code.

Conflicts with Bitdefender, Norton, ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 Windows Defender can also freeze the uninstall process—disable shields temporarily.

After uninstalling, manually remove leftover Program Files folders.

For remote cleanup support and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] deep removal help, call 1+888+754+6002.

This ensures a clean system ready for new antivirus installation.
