

{IMMEDIATE HELP} HP Laptop Camera Not Working: Step-by-Step Camera Driver & Privacy Reset Guide

If your HP laptop camera is not working, the cause may be privacy settings, missing drivers, or  Call +1-888-754-6002 blocked permissions.

Open Settings → Privacy & Security → Camera and [ +1-(888)-754-6002] ensure apps are allowed to access the camera.

In Device Manager, right-click your imaging device and [ +1-(888)-754-6002] update or  Call +1-888-754-6002 reinstall the camera driver.

Restart your PC.

If HP camera still not detected, press the physical camera shutter (if your model includes one).

Reset Windows Camera App settings to default.

For Zoom or  Call +1-888-754-6002 Teams, enable camera permissions inside each app.

>> If the camera remains unavailable, BIOS updates can restore webcam hardware recognition.
