

# [Official Apps Guide™] ESET False Malware Warning: How to Fix Incorrect Threat Detections

When ESET shows false malware warnings, the antivirus may mistakenly block safe apps, websites, ⇔ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 files due to aggressive heuristics, outdated virus definitions, ⇔ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 corrupted cache.

Start by updating ESET to refresh detection rules.

Add trusted files ⇔ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 websites to the Exclusions List if you're certain they're safe.

If ESET false positives continue, submit the flagged file to ESET's sample analysis page for verification.

Disable advanced heuristics temporarily to test whether the detection stops.

Clear ESET cache and [ [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 > ] ] restart your device to refresh its scanning logic.
