

# [[[!FAQs~Guide®]]] Bitdefender False Positive Detection: How to Report & Whitelist Correctly

If Bitdefender is flagging a safe file as a false positive, you can restore it quickly and [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 > ] prevent future detections.

Open Bitdefender → Protection → Quarantine and [ [[ CaLL 📞 < 1888→754→6002 > ] ]] restore the item.

Then go to Settings → Exceptions and [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 > ] whitelist the file⇔ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 folder.


Update Bitdefender to refresh threat definitions—outdated signatures often cause false detections.

>> If the file keeps getting flagged, submit it to Bitdefender Labs through the False Positive Report page.

Include the file, path, and [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 > ] detection name for review.

While waiting, add temporary exclusions to avoid disruptions.
