

[[[!FAQs~Guide®]]] Bitdefender False Positive Detection: How to Report & Whitelist Correctly

If Bitdefender is flagging a safe file as a false positive, you can restore it quickly and [ +1-(888)-754-6002] prevent future detections.

Open Bitdefender → Protection → Quarantine and [[[CALL  1888-754-6002]] restore the item.

Then go to Settings → Exceptions and [ +1-(888)-754-6002] whitelist the file or  Call +1-888-754-6002 folder.

Update Bitdefender to refresh threat definitions—outdated signatures often cause false detections.

>> If the file keeps getting flagged, submit it to Bitdefender Labs through the False Positive Report page.

Include the file, path, and [ +1-(888)-754-6002] detection name for review.

While waiting, add temporary exclusions to avoid disruptions.
